

## Tower Tours

## Straits of Mackinac Shipwreck Museum

Located in the reconstructed Warehouse, this exhibit features audiovisual displays and a variety of original



artifacts to tell the story of the numerous shipwrecks that dot the Straits of Mackinac. A film, *Shipwrecks of the Straits*, plays continuously throughout the day in the Barn.



A point in the storm and a guiding beacon since 1889, Old Mackinac Point Lighthouse helped passing ships navigate through the treacherous waters of the Straits of Mackinac. There's just as much to see from the top of the tower as inside the original buildings. Authentically restored quarters and exhibits, including the original lens, a film, *Shipwrecks*

of the Straits, and the Straits of Mackinac Shipwreck Museum, make this "Castle of the Straits" a true gem of the Great Lakes. The Keepers' Quarters contains three rooms restored to their 1910 appearance, a gallery exhibit on the history of the lighthouse, and an exhibit focusing on the science and technology of lighthouses featuring multiple interactive elements.
