



Fire the Cannon Procedures

To ensure the safety of everyone involved, the following rules will be observed regarding the cannon firing experience:

- Reservations must be made in advance. No walk-up reservations will be taken.
- Program is available throughout the operating season
- Program time varies by season. In May and early June, the program starts at 8:45 a.m. From early June into early October, the program begins at 9:15 a.m. In middle and late October, the program starts at 10:45 a.m. Inquire about exact start times when making your reservation.
- Participants must be 13 years old. A parent or guardian must also sign a waiver and be present for participants 13 to 17 years old.
- The guest firing the cannon must sign and submit a waiver/liability statement before beginning the activity.
- Fort Mackinac interpretive staff will be solely responsible for loading and priming the cannon. Visitors will not handle or load gunpowder into the cannon.
 - Only one member of your party may take part in the actual cannon firing experience. Other members of your party must stay behind the safety rope.
- Other members of your party must have a valid Fort Mackinac admission ticket.
 - Those using wheelchairs or with mobility impairments can usually be accommodated.
