Mackinac State Historic Parks to Host Seasonal Job Fair April 2

MACKINAW CITY, MICH. — Mackinac State Historic Parks will host a seasonal job fair on Saturday, April 2 at the Petersen Center in Mackinaw City from 11:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.

Mackinac State Historic Parks is hiring for seasonal positions in park operations and maintenance, sales and guest services, and natural and historic interpretation. Informal interviews will be available at the fair. Seasonal positions start at \$12/hour. Seasonal and recruitment bonuses available, and on-site housing is available both in Mackinaw City and on Mackinac Island.

There is no cost to attend this job fair. The Petersen Center is located at 207 West Sinclair, behind Darrow's at the intersection of Sinclair and Louvigny Streets. For more information call 231.436.4100.

Mackinac State Historic Parks is governed by the Mackinac Island State Park Commission, established in 1895 to protect, preserve and present the parks' rich historic and natural resources for the education and recreation of future generations.
