Preamble:

The restoration, reconstruction, and interpretation of the historic sites under the jurisdiction of the Mackinac Island State Park Commission are revenue bond financed (Act 451, P.A. 1994, Part 767, Section 76702 (d). Revenues are obtained from charges and fees for admission to and use of the services, facilities, and commodities supplied by and through the Historical Facilities System. (Bond resolution of June 18, 1982, p. 1927- 1991a)

General Policy

Fees and charges are established by the Commission (Minutes, October 5, 1984, p.2108 and 2111; also October 15, 1988, p. 2430) and must be sufficient to service outstanding bonds and to provide for the operation and maintenance of the Historical Facilities System.

All persons entering the Historical Facilities System pay the established fee excepting:

1. Mackinac Island State Park Commissioners
2. Employees of the Commission
3. Persons having business with the Commission or persons whose presence is deemed necessary by a Commissioner (Minutes, May 28, 1962, p.764 and Rule 46 (6), R318.146 of the Michigan Administrative Code)
