<u>Concessions</u> Revision: November 1, 2002

Act 451, P.A. 1994, Section 8115 Updated: February 1, 2012

## Preamble:

The Commission has the authority to grant and to establish fees or charges for concessions (Act 451, P.A. 1994, Section 8115). One such concession, Fort Mackinac Tea Room is currently in effect.

## General Policy

The existing concessions were granted to provide a necessary service to visitors, as no food or beverage service is otherwise conveniently available to them. Every effort is made to have the decor and menu in keeping with the historical atmosphere of the parks.

Requests for other type of concessions in the parks have been denied in recent years as not providing essential service to the public or as conflicting with the interest of bond holders. (See Administrative Code, R 318.146. Rule 46)
