Mackinac Island State Park Commission Policy

Use of Visitor's Center Dock

Preamble:

The former Coast Guard property which is now the Mackinac Island State Park Visitor's Center includes a small dock which is operated under the jurisdiction of the Commission and is used for park vessels.

General Policy:

The Mackinac Island Visitor's Center dock may be used with prior approval of the Director for vessels having business with the Commission, and in emergency situations for access for medical, police and fire protection purposes.

Beginning in 2006, the east side of the dock is made available, by Use Permit, for the accommodation of a single non-commercial vessel for the summer season (May 15 – October 15). The annual Use Permits are approved by the Commission.
