General Policy

The Mackinac Island State Park Commission bans the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages in Marquette Park in the Mackinac Island State Park, Mackinac Island, Michigan between 10:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m.

Marquette Park is defined as that portion of Mackinac Island State Park bounded on the south by Main Street, on the west by Fort Street, on the east by the leasehold known as “Anne’s Cottage”, and on the north by the bluff below Fort Mackinac.
