



Mackinac Island State Park Commission Policy

Natural Resources

Minutes: September 1975, p. 1546-7

Preamble:

The supply of sand and gravel in Mackinac Island State Park is limited and must be conserved. In the past, because of difficulties of obtaining such materials from the mainland, these resources have been made available to local residents. That policy is no longer feasible.

General Policy

Sand and gravel may not be furnished to private individuals. However, small quantities may be furnished to the City of Mackinac Island upon request for such public works projects as the repair of public sidewalks. A charge shall be made based upon the actual cost to the State, and all such receipts are to be deposited in the General Fund (Minutes September 1975, p.1546-7).
