Master Bond Resolution

Art. V, Sec.503(a)

Minutes: February 6, 1976, p. 1567

Preamble:

An Historical Publication Account in accordance with the master bond resolution of June 1982 is used to finance the publication for sale of books or pamphlets of historical or informational nature pertaining to the Mackinac area. Proceeds from the sales are deposited to the Historical Facilities Revenue Fund, and at least \$100,000 is required to be on deposit in the account at the beginning of each fiscal year (Article V, Section 503(a) of master bond resolution).

General Policy

Retail publication prices are generally established at twice actual publication costs to cover overhead and to allow for wholesale discounts.

Purchases of five copies or more of any one publication are subject to a 40 percent discount from the retail price (Minutes of February 6, 1976, p. 1567). Additional discounts as follows are allowed for large quantity purchases of hard cover publications having a retail price of at least \$12.50:

50 to 99	25 cents each
100 to 199	50 cents each
200 or more	75 cents each
