



Mackinac Island State Park Commission Policy

Swimming Pools

Minutes: March 10, 1989, p. 2445

Preamble:

Swimming pools on leased State Park land shall be permitted only in a manner consistent to the historical setting and appropriate to the natural site.

General Policy

A swimming pool is any pool containing water over two feet in depth constructed for the purpose of swimming and/or wading.

A request for a permit to erect a swimming pool must meet the following requirements:

- 1. The request must be in writing with a map of the intended pool site.
- 2. The location of the pool must be in the rear of lot and pool should not be visible from a public road.
- 3. Pool must be surrounded by a fence at least five feet high for safety. The design of the fence is submitted to the Director prior to construction for architectural review.
- 4. The pool must be at least ten feet from the property line.
- 5. Pool must be designed in conformity with State and local construction codes.
- 6. A copy of the liability insurance policy must be furnished in the amount of \$250,000 for each occurrence and \$500,000 aggregate protecting as additional insured the Mackinac Island State Park Commission, Department of Natural Resources and Environment, State of Michigan. Furthermore, the Mackinac Island State Park Commission and the State of Michigan and their agents, servants, and employees shall not be held liable for any injury or damages resulting from the use of said swimming pool.
- 7. The pool shall be used solely by the lessee and their guests and no fees may be collected for its use.
